**4** new farm businesses accessed land and equipment at our incubator farm

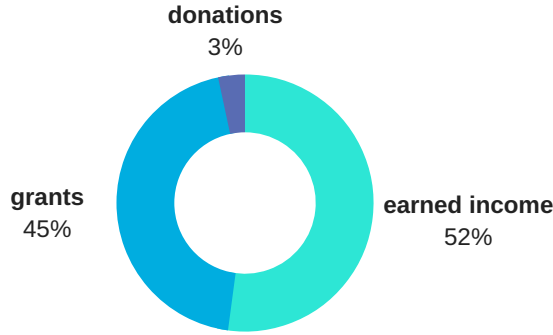
**\$335,772** of produce from **11** Whatcom County farms distributed through the Puget Sound Food Hub

**105** growers exchanged ideas at **6** free farmer roundtable workshops

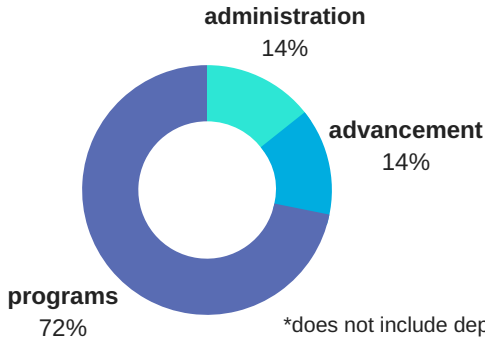
